Scope of Work: We are seeking 1 nanny to care for the Camp Directors' 5-year-old daughter and 2.5-year-old son who have both been attending a Montessori preschool for many years; and 1 nanny to care for the Program Director's 6-month-old son.

Care includes: preparing food, feeding, changing, bathing, teaching, reading and playing. Nannies plan each day with educational, engaging, and fun activities for the kids, preferably Montessori-based. Nannies interact with camp staff to access all camp facilities with the kids, such as the lake, art building, soccer fields, and rec deck. Nannies also prepare and drive the kids to scheduled appointments and lessons on time.

Accommodations: Nannies live in shared staff cabins with other camp staff members. Cabins are outfitted with fresh pine-paneling, full bathrooms, bunk beds, electricity, and screened windows.
