



PRIMARY and ASSISTANTS TO INFANCY (Modular) 2023-2024 FEES, TUITION AND PAYMENT PLANS

Fees and Tuition	Dates
Application Fee: \$150	Upon applying
Smart Tuition Fee: \$50 per year paid directly to Smart Tuition*	Upon acceptance*
International Student Fee: \$500 (only required for international students)	Upon acceptance
Primary Course Tuition: \$13,950	varies

Upon acceptance, a \$1,000 deposit is due to secure your space in the course and this deposit is applied toward your total tuition. The remaining tuition must be paid in full by April 1, 2023 in order for the student to be eligible to sit for the final exams. The following payment plans are offered. Any payment received 5 or more days after the designated due date will incur a \$40 late fee. Please contact amy@misdami.org if you know your payment will be late.

Payment Plan A – deposit & one payment

Payment Plan B – deposit & payment by semester

Second semester tuition	\$6,475	January 1, 2024

Payment Plan C – deposit & payment by month

First to Tenth Months Tuition	\$1295	July 1, 2023 - April 1, 2024; first day of each month

^{*}Enrollment in Smart Tuition is **required** of all students unless prior approval is obtained from MISD. If you have extenuating circumstances which prevent you from making payments via Smart Tuition, please contact MISD to discuss your situation. Students who do not enroll in Smart Tuition and who choose Payment Plan C (monthly) will incur a \$100 Administrative Fee. **Students who pay the full tuition** *with* **the deposit are not required to enroll in Smart Tuition and must contact the Training Center (training@misdami.org) to arrange direct payment.**

<u>AMI Membership</u>: It is an AMI requirement that all trainees have an active membership throughout the course of their training. You must provide an AMI membership number valid through the end of the calendar year (December 31st) for each summer of instruction. You should budget up to \$100 each year to complete this requirement. If you have a membership that will expire during the training, you will be required to renew it prior to registering, no exceptions. Any overlap in membership will be added to the end of your membership period.

Other Expenses: Please budget an additional \$700-\$1400 (Primary) or \$900-\$1600 (Assistants to Infancy) beyond the course tuition for books, supplies, student expenses, future classroom materials, transportation to observation and practice teaching, etc.
