

Real-World Math for Middle School Students

Looking for teacher who can conduct an independent middle school math class. This class will allow 7/8th grade students to see their math skills as an integrated whole as they work to solve real world math problems.

Teacher will:

- 1) Teach group lessons from Pre-Algebra textbook. Must have strong math skills.**
- 2) Conduct Discussion Groups where students are free to discuss how they came up with their answers and why. Candidate must create a safe environment where children know it's ok to make mistakes.**
- 3) Help students as needed with Project Based Learning**
