Position Overview:

Job responsibilities include working one-on-one with an Elementary student, to help him learn the skills to be successful at school. This is a unique opportunity to work in an Upper Elementary classroom with an experienced AMI Elementary teacher, practicing your observation and management skills with one child while also absorbing the culture of an established class.

Key Responsibilities Include the Following:

- Support student with work choice as directed by teacher

- Support student with self-regulation: Encourage student to remember his zones of regulation when frustrated, and observe patterns that lead to this.
- Communicate with teacher for updates on student progress
- Monitor, and report to teacher, student's level of success with increasing independence and the factors that contribute to that success.

- Experience with sensory regulation needs, great relationship skills
