



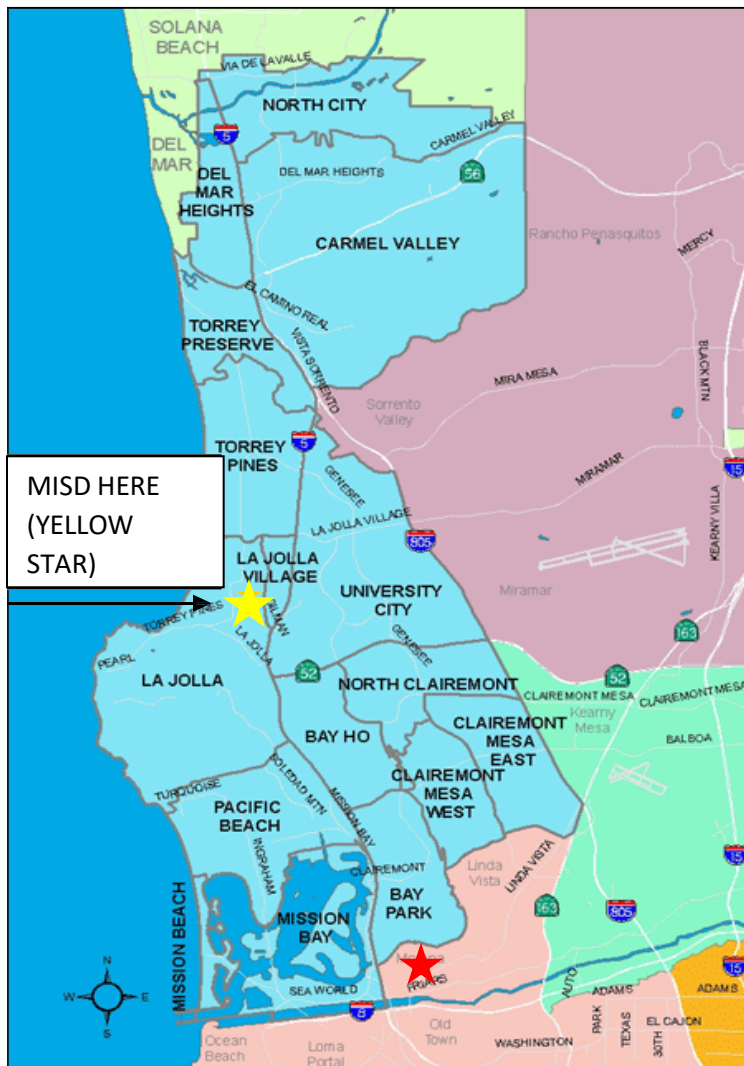
General Housing Information
